Update on Construction of the Sabal Palm Park at Central Parc

- **Sabal Palm Park** was first placed in the 5 year Capital Plan in the FY 2017 Adopted Budget, shortly after Commissioner Marlon Bolton was elected in 2016 to fulfill a promise to the Community that a Park would be constructed at Central Parc. In the 5 year plan, it was designated to be funded for development in FY 2019.
1. A public meeting was held with the Central Parc residents on January 29, 2019 to discuss what elements they would like to see in the park, as well as, any concerns they may have.
 2. Approximately 30 individuals attended the meeting.
 3. City received good feedback, **but it was from a small representation of the community.**
 4. City was also receiving some **negative** feedback about the development of the park as the parcel is located within the Central Parc Community and residents are concerned with large amounts of traffic going through to get to the park. Due to the negative comments, the City took a step back and determined the best strategy would be to contract for an outside firm to conduct an East Side Park Feasibility Study. The study would include the Sabal Palm Parcel

residents to provide input.

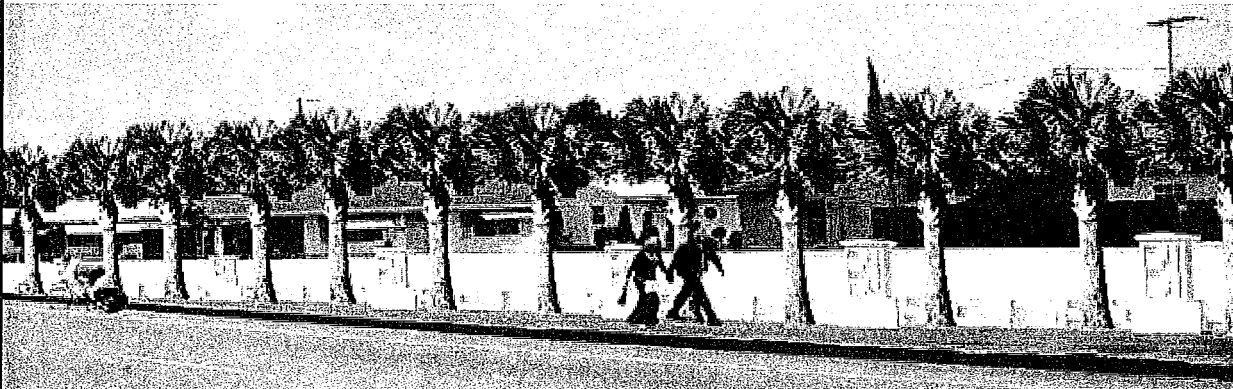
6. These contracted professionals will come back with recommendations for elements to be placed in the park. The study is scheduled for completion in **June 2021**
 - Due to the City wanting feedback from as many residents as possible, which included the feasibility study, the development of the Sabal Palm project was placed in the **FY 2022** Budget for funding
 - A follow up meeting will be scheduled for **Summer 2021** with residents of **Central Parc** to present proposed elements based upon study and feedback received.

Timeline:

1. **Fiscal year begins October 1, 2021**
2. **The City staff will develop design criteria to place in the Request For Proposal which will go out for bid in December 2021 (Dates below are projected)**
3. **The bid process will be a 2 step process with a contractor being selected and agreement being taken to City Commission in Spring 2022**
4. **Design and permitting to be complete in Fall/winter 2022**
5. **Construction to begin Fall/Winter 2022**
6. **Completion projected Winter 2023**

MISSING TREES ON COMMERCIAL BLVD?

A NEW WALL IS COMING!



Dear Woodland Greens Community,

Through community concerns and follow up field investigations, it was brought to the City's attention that the root structure of the large mature trees located within the landscape median fronting the Woodland Greens Community was creating significant drainage and roadway infrastructure issues. Upon further investigation, it was determined that this median could no longer support the very large root structure of these trees, which was already compromising the roadway and drainage infrastructure within NW 58th Place and Commercial Boulevard. In addition to the roadway and drainage infrastructure issues, there were also underlying concerns with an existing 12" main water and the streetlighting electrical powerlines located within this median.

mosquitos, allowing for health concerns. Your neighbors have complained about this on numerous occasions.

After careful consideration and working with Broward County's Environmental Protection and Growth Management Department, Landscaping Division, it was determined that these trees had to be removed and a tree mitigation plan needed to be created within the City of Tamarac, to replace the existing tree canopy.

In addition to replacing the tree canopy, the City began to work on the design of a buffer wall system to be located within this median. This buffer wall project, which will include milling and resurfacing NW 58th Place, together with the associated curb replacement, is currently under design. Following the completion of the design, this project will go out for bid through the City's competitive bidding process for the construction of the proposed buffer wall.

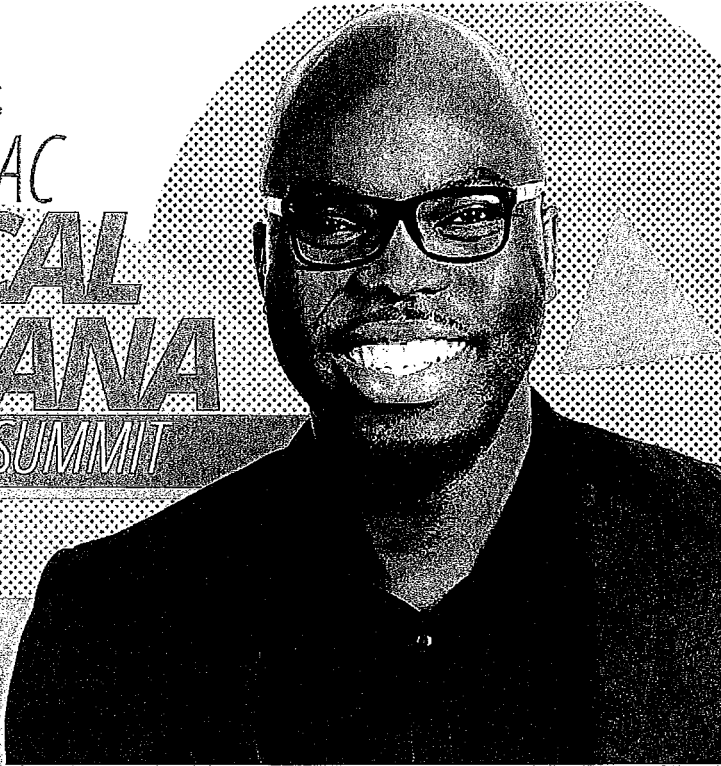

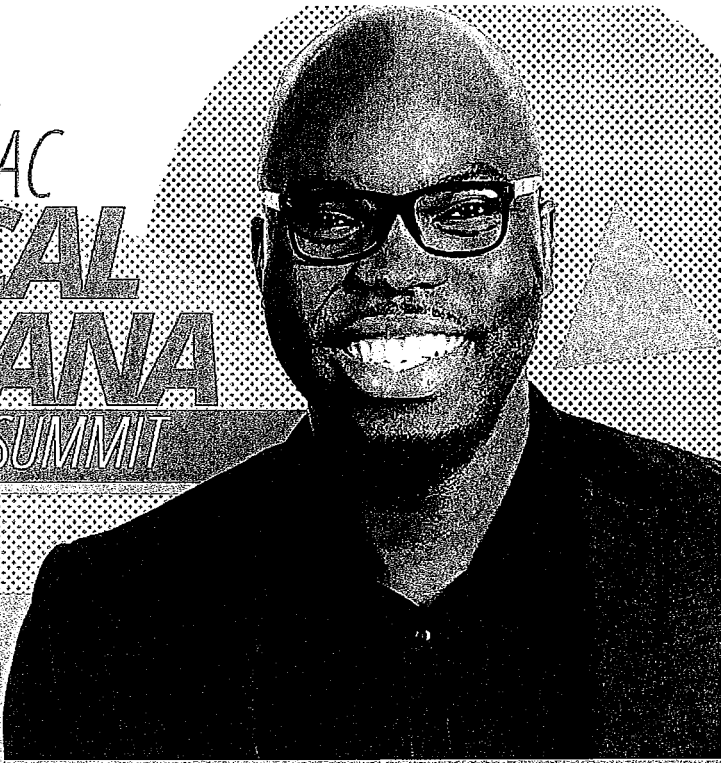
